About Getting Prepared for Success (GPS)

GPS is a fee-based program that provides students with the opportunity to learn about UConn, including campus resources, support services, and strategies needed to help be successful.

Students participating in GPS will participate in a three-day experience before the semester begins to support their transition to campus. Students will interact with Strategy Instructors, who are graduate students studying Education, Social Work, or Educational Psychology.

Day 1: Virtual Orientation about the expectations of the program

Day 2: Move in and participate in activities to increase familiarity with campus

Day 3: Learn strategies to increase academic success as a UConn Student
